Waiver Information

Running MINIs On Top involves working with many great venues and complying with their policies so we can have a safe and fun event. Times have changed, and our venue partners now require us to carry event liability insurance. We are happy to announce our partnership with the BMW Car Club of America (CCA) – they are providing coverage for our event at no cost to us.

One of the requirements for securing an insurance policy for our type of event is the collection of a signed liability waiver for each event attendee. We understand that this is a new requirement and an inconvenience, so we have worked to make it as quick and painless as possible. Here's what you need to do:

- 1. Head to [Eventbrite](#) (password is MOT2021) and select the same number of event tickets (for free) that you already purchased from the MINIs On Top webstore. This allows us to collect the names and email addresses of each attendee in your party (something we haven't needed to do before). Please let everyone in your party know where to go and what to do. You do NOT need to print or bring this ticket to the event.**
- 2. Each member of your party should complete the e-waiver set up by BMW CCA [here](#), this works best on a mobile device – a selfie is required.**
 - a. Contact a legal professional should you have any questions regarding the waiver. The MINIs On Top organizers can provide no council.**
 - b. For attendees under the age of 18:**
 - i. Parents/legal guardians can complete the waiver on behalf of the attendee**
 - ii. Legally licensed drivers (who plan to drive a car at the event) can complete a waiver with parent/legal guardian permission**
- 3. Email insurance@minisontop.org confirming you have completed your waiver. You will receive a thank you gift for your time helping us out.**

FAQ

1. Why is this now required?

a. Our venues now require we hold this insurance, and waivers are a requirement of the policy. This is a routine process that allows us to continue holding MINIs On Top.

2. I can't access Eventbrite and/or the e-waiver. What should I do?

a. Contact insurance@minisontop.org for assistance. If you still cannot access the e-waiver, you will need to sign a paper waiver at the event.

3. What are my options if I decline to sign?

a. We hope that you will reconsider. This insurance allows us to continue running MINIs On Top at our wonderful venues. If you decline signing, we will void your registration and refund the portion of your order that is not already committed.
